Prayers for the world

India and Bangladesh

Heavy monsoon rains have caused rivers to burst their banks across NE India and Bangladesh, destroying crops and displacing many thousands. In Assam alone, 400,000 people from 850 villages are affected. Pray for rescue efforts and for families who've lost the little they own.

Yemen

An estimated 300,000 people have been infected by cholera, with 7,000 new cases every day and 1700 deaths. The 2yr conflict has taken a heavy toll on water supplies, sanitation and health services. Pray for Tearfund partners distributing water containers, chlorine tablets and soap, and promoting better hygiene practices. Pray also for peace.

Climate Change

The Paris Agreement has suffered a setback with the withdrawal of the US. Pray that other countries will become more determined than ever to fulfill their part of the agreement. Pray too for those in poor countries which take the impact of climate change.

Iraq

Mosul is now back in Govt hands, with fighting (almost) over. Pray for the 700,000 who fled the city with few possessions, and for those who stayed - thousands are at last accessible and urgently in need of aid.
